Members of the Academy are mostly professors, associate professors, researchers and Ph.D. degree holders who once served or are now serving in the various universities, colleges and institutions of the Ministry of Education.

Seminars

- Since the establishment of the Academy bi-monthly seminars and discussions have been conducted covering a wide variety of subjects from philosophy and nanotechnology to the Asian financial crisis and bioethics. Speakers from within the Academy and scholars from other disciplines have presented their views and led the stimulating and lively discussions. To date learned speakers have spoken on 45 different topics.
- An annual research conference has been held every year to commemorate the founding of the Academy with participants from universities and colleges throughout the country. The

Meetings

The Executive Committee of the Academy holds regular monthly meetings on the first Wednesday of every month to discuss progress of work and future

programmes. This has been a regular feature of the Academy since its establishment in 1999 and the meeting held on 4 October 2006 is its 87th meeting.

- A team led by the President, Vice-Presidents as well as some members of the EC visit the University of Mandalay at least twice a year to hold coordination meetings with members of the Academy from universities and colleges of Upper Myanmar.

- Coordination meetings are held with Heads of Departments or their representatives to discuss academic and research matters such as the annual research conference and publication of the Myanmar Academy of Arts and Science Research Journal.
- An annual conference is held every year to submit the annual report to members of the Academy.

- The EC members meet informally on occasions such as the Full Moon Day of Thadingyut to pay respect to the older members in keeping with Myanmar culture and tradition.
